UNIFORM AGREEMENT
FOR TRANSFER OF A PLAYER

TO OR BY A
Major League
Club

This Agreement, made and entered into this 17th day of December, 1919,
by and between Boston American League Baseball Club
and American League Baseball Club of New York

Witnesseth: The party of the first part does hereby release to the party of the second
part the services of Player George H. Ruth under the following conditions:

By heretofore existing in the party of the second part the
contract of said player George H. Ruth for the seasons of 1919,
1920 and 1921, in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five Thousand
Dollars (\$25,000.00) Dollars and other good and valuable consideration
paid to the party of the second part, heretofore made, hereby acknowledged.

The terms of the foregoing contract entered into by all persons of the National Agreement and in all other
of the National Agreement, including the terms of the contract of a player heretofore made under the National Agreement
of the National Agreement.
